3D Nail Art Contest Recap for all Districts & State

To be provided by contestant:

 One <u>practice hand of any kind</u> prepared prior to contest as specified with appropriate tips, and pre- base acrylic color theme



- One prepared practice hand of any kind displaying the 3D nail art design on 5 fingers as demonstrated in the notebook provided to judges. This hand will be displayed at the contestant's station during the contest. The contestant's number should be visibly labeled on the display hand.
- Theme is Disney
- A UV light (optional)
- Up to two different types / bottles of clear top coat, clear gel top coat (optional)
- Student must supply their own tools and equipment to complete 3D acrylic nail design application

The following items are **NOT ALLOWED**:

Gems, Skins, Feathers, Rhinestones, Glitters, Threads, Fabrics, Foils, Beads, Tapes, Crystals, Jewelry, Paints, Gels, Molds, Stencils, Transfer Foils, Stamping Plates

Scope of the Contest:

2-hour time limit. There is a written knowledge test required for this contest. The content of the test on general nail care knowledge will come from the Milady Textbook of Cosmetology, 30-minute time limit. Nail application: Any tip size and any tip length are acceptable, with height no more than ¼ inch. The practice hand, of any kind, used for the contest must have the nails including the base acrylic applied. Students may only use monomer and polymer during the contest. Any brand is ok and does not have to be odorless. 3-D gel application is not allowed. Orientation: Mandatory in correct uniform with kit and folder.
