

Welcome to the District 8 Photography Contest. You will be competing and showcasing your talents. Listed below is the equipment you will need for Saturday February 26th at 9am.

### **Equipment Needed**

Computer with photoshop loaded and able to run

One DSLR or mirrorless camera with removable lens capabilities

SD card for camera

Battery for Camera

SD Card reader if computer doesn't have one

Adobe Photoshop (be sure Photoshop can open the camera's RAW files)

**All competitors must create a one-page résumé and submit a hard copy to the technical committee chair at orientation. Failure to do so will result in a 10-point penalty.**

This will be in 2 parts. You will need to bring 2 images **8x10 that you took PRINTED** to turn in at the beginning of the contest when you arrive. The second part will be on location. You will be given a topic. You will be asked to take 3 pictures. You will use these 3 pictures to produce a creative conceptual piece of art.

You will have one hour to take your 3 pictures and 2 hours to edit them. If you finish taking your pictures you can begin editing them. You will not receive an extension of time. All conceptual art will be submitted by 12:15pm. Any entries submitted after that time will receive a penalty. Any entries past 1:00pm will be disqualified.
