- Volunteers can judge projects that the students have created to compete. These projects are in areas such as: automotive, marine, diesel, motorcycle, drafting, construction trades, culinary, cosmetology, AV, programming, engineering, internetworking and photography.
- Volunteers can judge live competitions in categories of skilled tasks, leadership and occupational related. These competitions include areas listed above as well as: customer service, job interviews, extemporaneous and prepared speaking, job skills demonstration, quiz bowls, AV and robotics.
