Registration Types to Choose

- **Contestant:** All students competing in a career competition should register in this category. This includes interview contestants for American Spirit, Chapter Display, Promotional Bulletin Board, Occupational Health and Safety and Outstanding Chapter.
- Participant: Student members, state officers and delegates should register in this category. (Students who are models for Esthetics or Nail Care and who are backups to competitors should also register in this category.)
- Advisor: SkillsUSA advisors or educators who are attending conference.
- Administrator (NEW): Principal, Assistant Principal, Counselor, Chancellor, Dean, President, Vice President, Director, Department Head, CTE Director or any other administrator.
- **Models of Excellence**: Participants who have been notified by the SkillsUSA national office that have achieved the highest honor of the Chapter Excellence Program should register in this category. These registrants will be interviewed as Models of Excellence at NLSC.

Children: Tickets for entertainment venues, or any event not mentioned in the children's registration descriptions below are not part of the child's registration. These admissions can be purchased separately onsite. Child — Free registration (age 10 and under) Registration includes access to conference floor at Georgia World Congress Center. Admission to general sessions at State Farm Arena are not included. Purchase the Child Session Pass to include admission to the general sessions. Child Session Pass – Paid Registration (ages 10 and under) Registration includes access to conference floor at Georgia World Congress Center, Champions Festival, and admission to the general sessions at State Farm Arena. o Children three and under may sit on an adult's lap at State Farm Arena general sessions at no charge. Free Sessions at NLSC w Badge

- ▶ Academy of Excellence: Registration for these sessions is included in NLSC registration fee for advisors, teachers, administrators and counselors. Format: Drop-in participation format.
- ➤ SkillsUSA University offers all registered NLSC attendees a chance to learn directly from industry expert practitioners and gain field-specific skills which they can later incorporate into their classroom instruction.
- ➤ SkillsUSA TECHSPO offers all registered NLSC attendees an opportunity to engage directly with partners from industry and education on the exhibit hall/competition floor.

NLSC Contestant Reminders

Resumes: All competitors must create a one-page resume and submit via online portal. No upload=10 point penalty. Testing information along with resume upload instructions will be sent to your students email address on file. Registration: USE EMAIL ADDRESS THAT CAN RECEIVE EMAILS AFTER JUNE 1st and a HOME ADDRESS not the school address.

Professional Development Testing via the SkillsUSA Online Testing Platform. Registered competitors will receive an email to the email address supplied in NLSC conference registration with their assigned username, password, and login URL. All Professional Development **Tests must be completed by 5 p.m. ET on Friday, June 9** to be scored. Action Skills, Building Maintenance, Community Action Project, Employment Application Process, and all middle school competitors are not required to complete the Professional Development test and will thus not be enrolled in a test.

Additional Online Testing

Competitors from select contests will also have a technical assessment for their contest loaded into their online testing account. Quiz Bowl, TeamWorks and Welding will have an online preconference assessment test and will receive test at the same time as the PD Test.

Competitors in the Baking and Pastry Arts and Culinary Arts will complete an online third-party assessment(s) and will receive instructions via email.

You must register in advance if you want to participate in Community Service event on Friday morning. Don't forgot to check that box in registration.

The Need

NLSC Delegates-Includes National Officer Voting

As a result of the SkillsUSA Delegate Program, the SkillsUSA mission is achieved by ensuring delegates are able to: Demonstrate Responsibility and Decision Making to make informed organizational decisions by engaging in training about parliamentary procedure and the decision-making process to execute the responsibilities of a delegate.

Evaluate local and state needs related to career and technical education and SkillsUSA. Collaborate with peer delegates to analyze organizational goals, consider state-level needs and provide input that represents their state's student membership and contributes to the achievement of the national organization mission.

The Delegate Program will be held June 20-23, 2022.

Delegates can also be contestants, but schedules should not conflict.

Before May 8th you can mark the delegate box in the student's registration for your designated voter. Once you arrive in Atlanta and find that the chosen delegate is not able to vote due to contest conflict or other circumstances you can notify Crystal as soon as you can to make the switch. This notification must happen 2 hours before the vote to make change official. The official process will be released after registration closes. Crystal will need the following information to make the substitution:
