Spam Warning Regarding "SkillsUSA Lists of Attendees" Emails

Please be advised that SkillsUSA NEVER sells lists of attendees from our conferences. Recent emails to staff and others have offered the National Leadership & Skills Conference attendee email list for a fee. These emails are spam. If you receive an email like this or any email related to SkillsUSA that seems suspicious in any way, please let us know by forwarding it to anyinfo@skillsusa.org.

UIL Contest Dates

The UIL calendar is set based on multiple parameters, mostly working around state standardized testing dates and avoiding conflicts with other UIL events. They attempt to also look at other activities, but as you know, the multitude of offerings for students continues to grow and the spring calendar continues to get more crowded. They have a date range of one week that districts can set their district meet dates. This year it is April 1-6 for most academic events and April 1-13 for speech events. Each district can set the date for their meet within that window based on the recommendations from coaches with the administrators on the District Executive Committee having final say. They limit the competition window to one week due to test confidentiality, as well as require students competing against one another to test at the same time and location.

The best option is for teachers who do both UIL and Skills USA to make the conflict of Skills and UIL contests known so that their UIL district contest can be set earlier in the week by their DEC, if at all possible.

National Registration System Updates

The Registration System for membership and conference registration will begin forcing users to reset their passwords using the new password character requirement: Minimum 8 characters long (mix of upper/lower case, alphanumeric and special characters).


