Lowes Grants Available

Lowe's has announced they will provide \$250,000 in grants for SkillsUSA chapters. The grants are for up to \$15,000 per chapter to upgrade classroom tools or equipment; purchase additional materials and supplies for students; or to obtain equipment, materials and supplies to conduct a community service project. The grants are focused on the construction cluster including Cabinetmaking, Carpentry, Electrical Construction Wiring, Heating, Ventilation, Air Conditioning and Refrigeration (HVACR), Masonry, Plumbing, Sheet Metal, Welding and Architectural Drafting. All funds must be spent at Lowe's stores. Applications open Sept. 1 and must be submitted by Sept. 30. Successful applicants will

After August 1st, 2023 all invoices that are past due will incur a \$50 past due fee per invoice on a monthly basis until payment is received. Member Registration is Open -- Join Early as a Professional

The SkillsUSA registration site is open for the 2023-24 school year! Advisors join early so you receive all mailings and emails. Joining and paying as a professional member is required for access to Aborb and the national technical standards. Professional members receive many benefits when they submit membership with a valid email address, including the SkillsUSA Framework Integration Toolkit, Program of Work Toolkit, SkillsUSA Championships Technical Standards (available in October), Jump into Stem curriculum, E-Courses and professional development opportunities.

Student membership is \$16/pp, advisors are \$40/pp for the year.

You can add your students now and wait to join/pay until January if you choose. Advisors can join/pay now for added benefits. You and your students are not officially joined until you click JOIN NOW, you can select which individuals you want to join at any one time and can submit more than one invoice. The SkillsUSA Elevate Chapter Officer Development Conference is Oct. 11 from 11 a.m.–4:30 p.m. ET.

This virtual interactive experience for local chapter officer teams focuses on building successful chapters by equipping officers with the skills to lead and serve their members. Successful completion of this conference supports the quality of local SkillsUSA programming and the individual growth of members as it activates SkillsUSA's mission to empower members to become skilled professionals, career-ready leaders and responsible community members.

After participating in Elevate, chapter officers will be able to:

- Use Self-Motivation, Communication, Teamwork and Planning, Organizing and Management to serve and lead their chapter members.
- Lead chapter members in their development of Framework skills through intentional incorporation of the skills in chapter Program of Work activities.

Implement a four-step process of planning high-quality and successful chapter activities that align with a Program of Work category and include goals, Essential Element instruction, a plan to achieve, and an evaluation.

Elevate is open to all SkillsUSA chapter officers but at least one advisor must participate with each registered team. Chapters participate right from their classroom and the cost is only \$10 per participant.
