

Membership Deadlines

• <u>Must be JOINED as a member to register for district</u> <u>contest.</u> Remember to use a personal email not school email when entering your students.



- <u>Must be a fully joined member by Feb 1st (or district registration deadline) to compete, be a model, or a substitute for contest.</u> Membership must be **PAID** before state contest registration deadline. Check/CC received before deadline.
- Membership cannot be transferred to another person or cancelled once joined.

- Use a price quote only for PO, only an M invoice is trackable for payment.
- Membership payments are due to Leesburg, VA not the PO Box in Lubbock.
- The state office cannot process membership payments, check will be sent back.

Best Practices for District Registration


- HAVE A PLAN B: You do not want your students to work on a project all year for one student to fail and them not be able to submit it or present it to the judges. Make sure you have an extra person ready.
- Double check your registration before the submission date. You must submit on or before your submission date. There will be no late registration. All unsubmitted registrants will be deleted after registration closes. On slide 5 you will see the substitution and cancellation dates for each district. There can be no cancellations, substitutions or refunds made after the dates. There will be no on-site registration.
- Your invoice, this is proof of registration, the fee estimate is only for your information. You cannot use the fee estimate to pay for registration you need your invoice and you will only get that after you submit. The invoice number will start with the letter "S". All invoices that start with the letter "S" will be sent to the Lubbock office for payment processing, not Virginia. You will find that address on your invoice please make sure you're submitting your payments to the correct address and they are made out to the correct entity.
- Check your District schedules for registration and substitution deadlines. This was discussed and slide 5. The close dates and substitution dates may be different from district to district.
- Schedules are subject to change. Once the schedules are posted please keep a close eye on them. From time to time things can change. There is an updated date at the bottom of each schedule. The most current date is the schedule you will want to follow.
- Delegates: you will receive your allotted delegate bracelets in your registration packet. You can choose who you would like to serve as a delegate for your school. You do not have to register anyone as delegate.

Registration



You must click SUBMIT to get prompts for producing an invoice. If you don't have an "S" invoice (not a fee estimate) you are not registered.

- Once you submit you cannot change your registration information. We can delete your invoice if you need to make a change. Please contact your district director.
- Advisors/students must be tagged with the chapter number for invoices to show properly. Do not submit for the school unless you are certain everyone is complete.
- If you need to change a PO number or a date for your accounting office let Amy know. We will work with you on not missing deadlines.
- When you resubmit an invoice there will be a different invoice




Email Address for Registration


If you have not put your students email in for membership registration, you cannot enter it in competition registration. You will need to return to membership registration and correct it there. (see below)

You need to use the students personal email addresses or have your school white list SkillsUSA.

Many schools do not allow outside emails to go to student accounts.



Click on members, Edit. Once you have edited the information you need to edit, Save it.



Once all of your information is correct in membership go back to registration. This information will carry over to this page.



PD Testing/Resume/Job Exhibit Photo Upload

Shortly after registration closes students and their advisors will receive an email

- one for all individual contest registered in
- seperate email for all the team events they are registered in

This email contains a link to the competitor's portal where students will be able to access their professional development test, upload resume, upload Job Exhibit required documents.

This email reminds students of their submission and testing windows.






Competitor's Portal Login Screen




Sample screenshot of contestant in one contest

Delegates and Voting

Number of Delegates Per Chapter: Each Texas chapter will have: a. one delegate for the Texas chapter b. one delegate for each group of 10 members c. one delegate for major fraction of 10 members (more than 5) i.e. 16 members = 3 voting delegates; 15 members = 2 voting delegates

Register Delegates to Vote:

You will receive allotted number of delegate bracelets in your registration packet. You can assign those to who you choose. There is not a setting in registration this year to designate your delegates. Can be different students at district than at state.

What Delegates are Voting on:

At your district delegate session there may be a Constitution and Bylaw Amendment to vote on. There will also be district officer candidate speeches and voting to elect your district officer panel. Delegate wristbands will be in your registration packet for your to distribute to students available to vote.

How Delegates Vote:

Each district will have own process, may be hand raise or online.

Professional Development District Testing

- Must register students with *non school email* to get log in directions.
- Online testing link will be emailed to students after registration closes.
- The test link will be open starting the day after registration closes. The tests must be completed no later than the day after substitutions are allowed. Check your district page to confirm the date.
- The window is open 24hrs a day for the days listed by district. *No make up dates*.
- Test should be teacher/advisor proctored, you will have to click confirm for both proctor and student.
- One test score applies to all contests that student has entered.
- Substitution students will have 24 hours to take the test. Please verify student receives email with testing link
- If the student does not take test within that window they get ZERO score. *No exceptions*. Please plan accordingly. Team scores are averaged.
- Advisors should confirm the log in directions have been received by students and have a plan to proctor the test *prior* to registration closing.
- If the log in has not been received reach out to your coordinator **before** testing day you will need the email address you used for registration.
- Any issues with online testing should be directed to your district director: Eddy, Darlene or Amy.

Awards and Scholarship Applications

- <u>District Officer Application and State Officer Application</u> If you/student are struggling to complete these applications online, they can be printed and submitted as PDF. (bottom of form "Preview PDF" to print)
- Advisor of the Year The application are posted and available on your district webpage. Deadline will be last day of district competition registration.
- <u>SkillsUSA Outstanding Member Scholarship</u>- Applications are posted on each district's website. Candidates interview at district and one student from each district advances to state to potentially receive \$1,000 from CTAT.
- Honorary Life Membership award Each year, it is awarded to individuals for their outstanding service that advances the mission and values of the SkillsUSA organization. Online applications due Feb. 14
