SkillsUSA National Competitor Portal Login Details | Deadline June 6, 2024

Congratulations! You have put in the hours to master your craft and hone your skills to earn a spot at this year's SkillsUSA National Leadership and Skills Conference. Check both the current edition of the SkillsUSA Technical Standards for your respective competition and the Competition Updates page of the SkillsUSA website to learn about any required national pre-conference online submissions/testing. **Important:** The competition updates posted online provide members with the latest information about themes, clarifications, professional development test study guide, national competitor online submission/testing requirements and more. A competition update covers anything that is not listed in the official SkillsUSA Championships Technical Standards and that a competitor and/or advisor needs to be aware of and bring and/or complete for the national competition. Please check this site regularly prior to the conference for any updates to your competition.

Reminder: you must complete all your pre-conference requirements by **5 p.m. ET on Thursday, June 6, 2024**. We recommend that you complete the online requirements as soon as possible to ensure you meet the deadline. If you experience technical difficulties, the SkillsUSA Customer Care Team can assist competitors with gaining access to either the Competitor Portal or their online testing account. You can verify your online submissions using the Competitor Portal. The dashboard will display a list of your uploaded files. If you need to replace an existing uploaded file, you will need to submit a new copy of the updated document with the same file name by the submission deadline.

SkillsUSA Online Test Requirements:

Unless otherwise noted, each national competitor is required to complete the online pre-conference SkillsUSA Professional Development Test. The link to the required online test(s) will be available from your Competitor Portal. Your test proctor will provide directions when you are allowed to take the SkillsUSA Professional Development Test (or any other assigned competition test(s)). When ready, click the desired link on the right side of your Competitor Portal for the 'Prof. Development Test' or 'Online Skills Test'. You will login to the ProProfs Testing Site using the same credentials provided above.

Online Test Security:

1. **DO NOT** open a test until directed to do so by an approved proctor, as you will have only ONE attempt to launch your test(s).
2. All testing must be completed by the competitor without any external aid under the direct supervision of a qualified proctor. *(External aids include, but are not limited to, other students, advisors, parents, industry experts, textbooks, search engines, web pages, and/or any other external source of knowledge. A qualified proctor is defined as any willing adult who is not the competitor's SkillsUSA advisor and who has no familial relation to the competitor.)*
3. Competitors get one attempt at the test and must always remain in the testing window. **Opening any other tab or window during the testing process will automatically submit your test on suspicion of cheating.**
4. Once you submit a test, you can visit your online testing platform dashboard to verify that a checkmark is visible next to the required test(s) which indicates completion.


