

How to Access the SkillsUSA Technical Standards



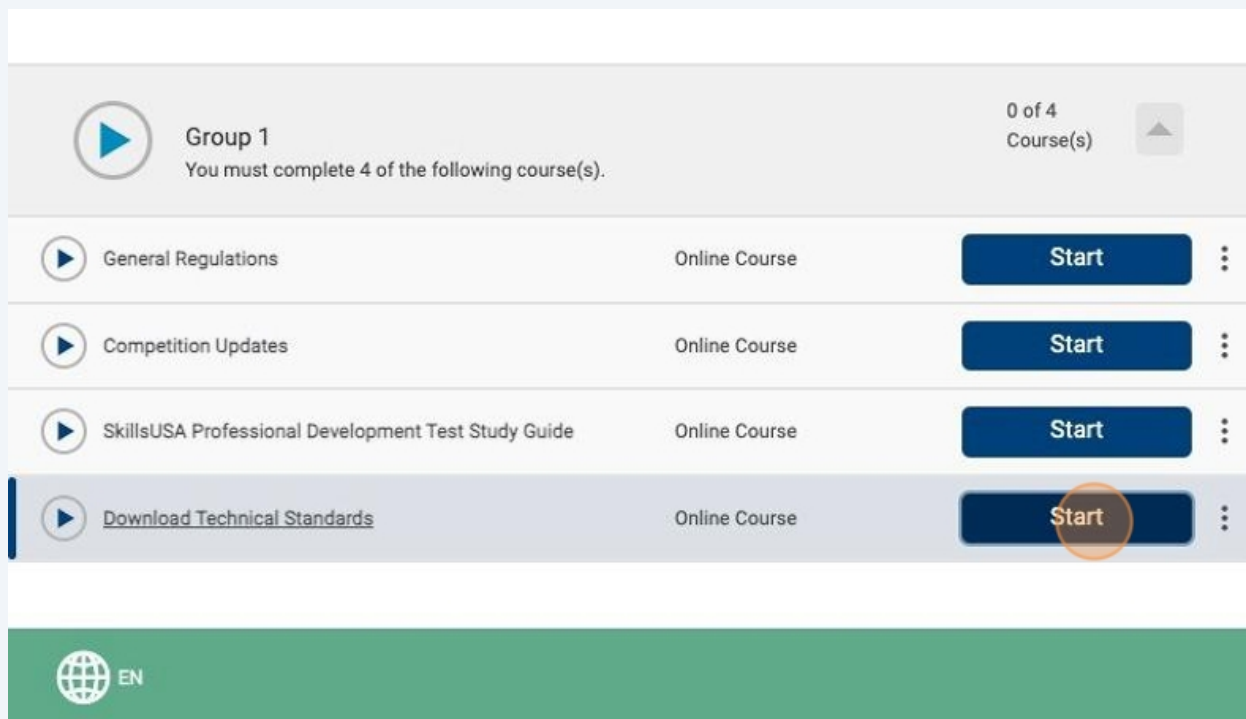




Depending how your webpage is set up, you will be able to view the different competitions with the **two arrows** pointing up below

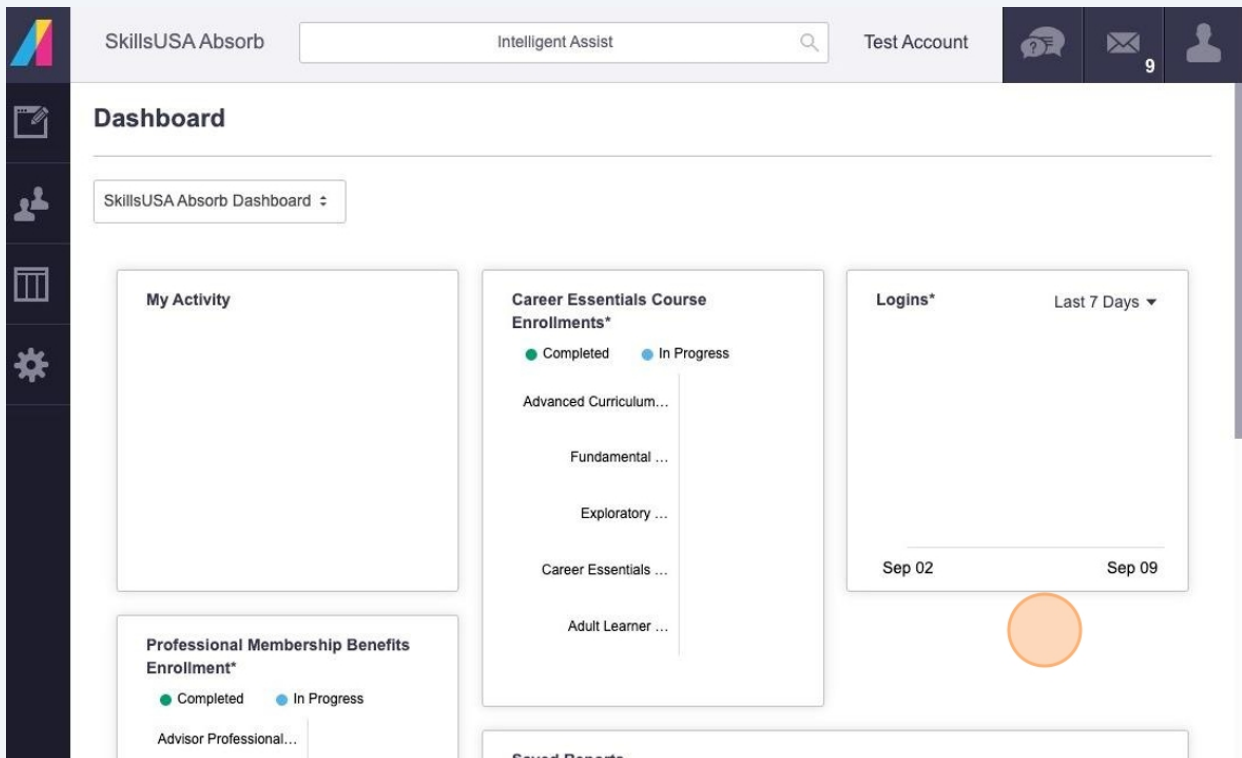

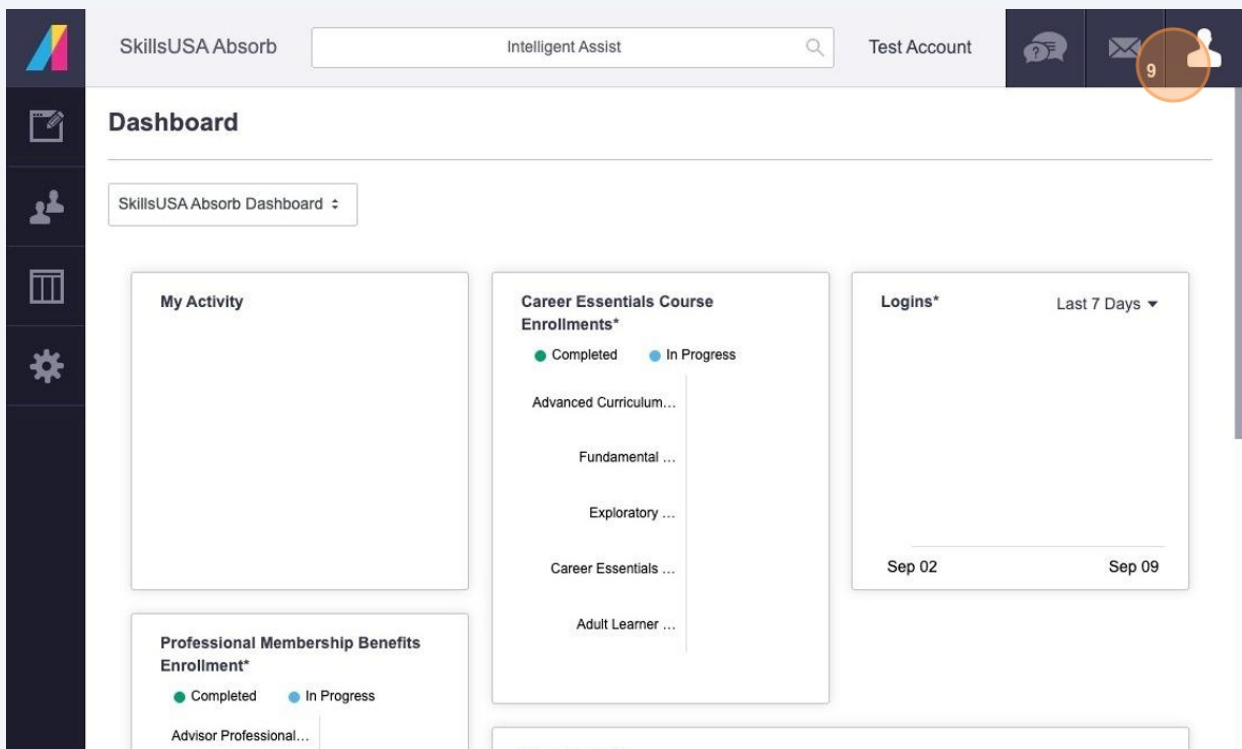

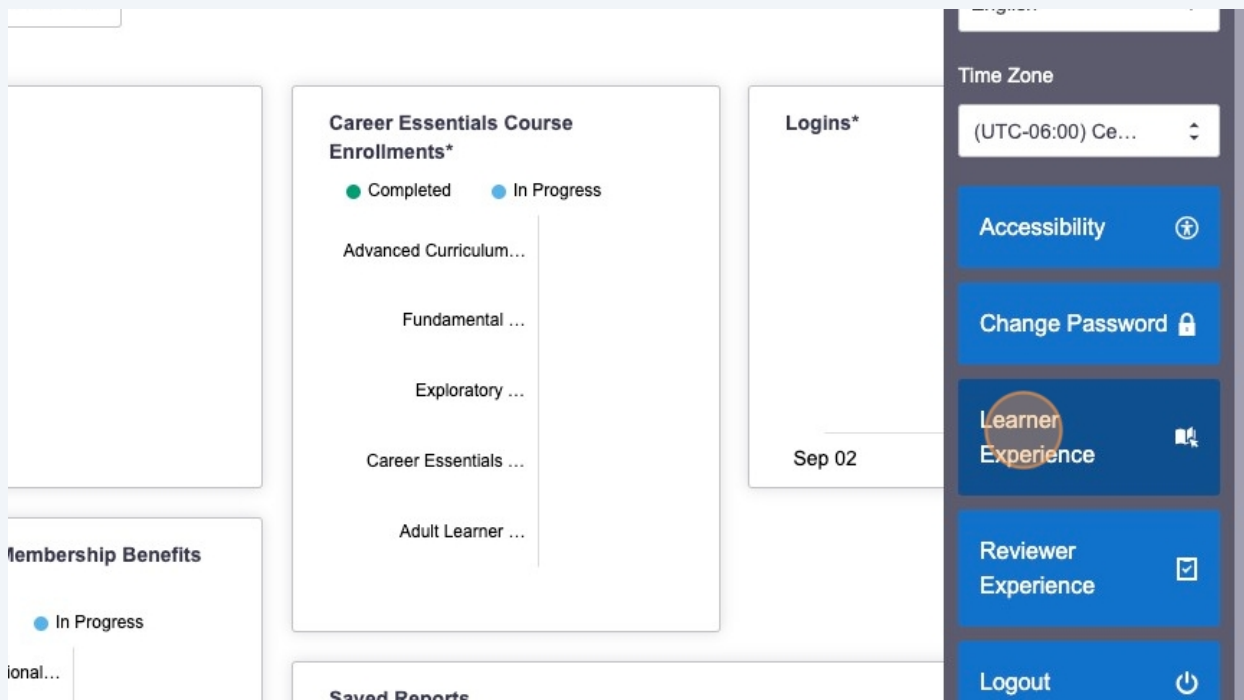
