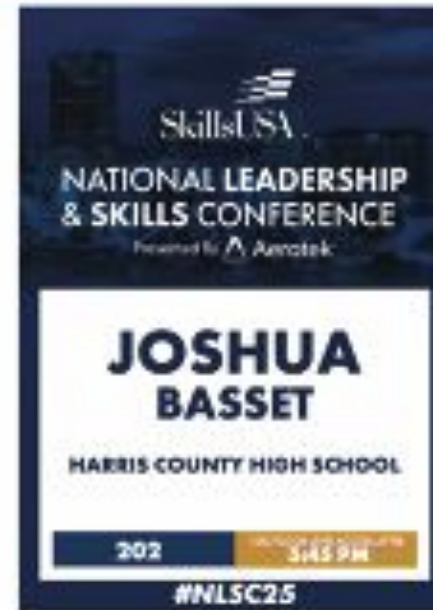

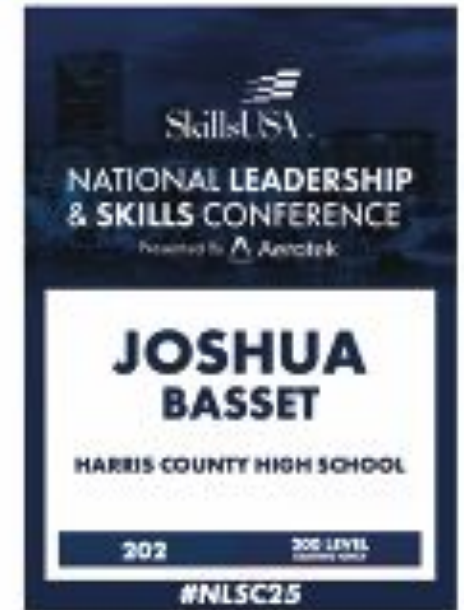
Badges labeled "OPEN SEATING" or "LOWER BOWL" may access the 100 and Floor Levels at any time during the show.

TIMED ACCESS




Badges labeled with "ACCESS AFTER 5:45 PM" may only access the 100 and Floor Levels after 5:45 PM

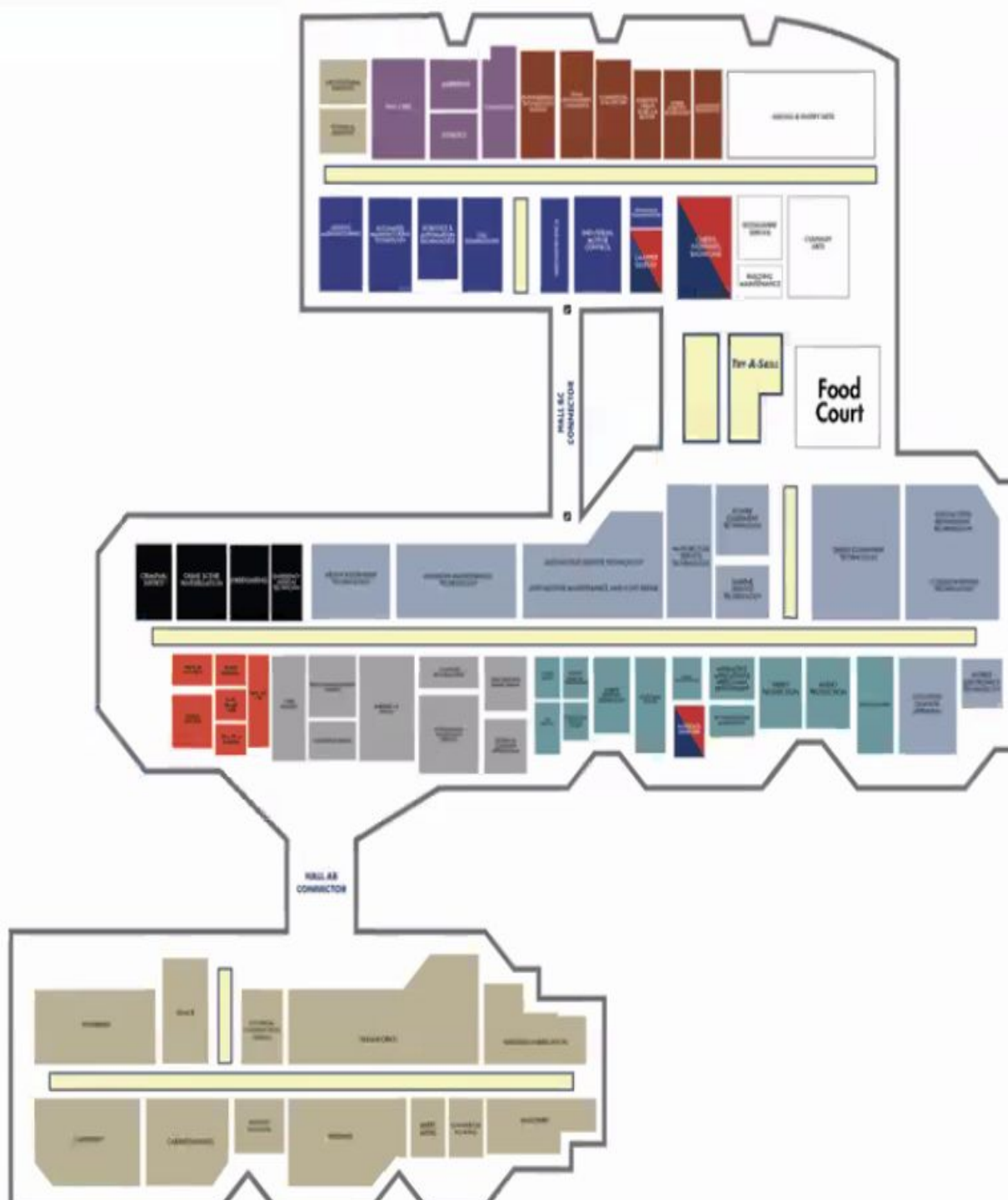
